# Regular School Board Meeting Minutes Wawasee CTE Building December 10, 2019, 5:30 P.M.

A work session was held prior to the regular board meeting, which consisted of a tour of the Wawasee Career Tech Building.

Mrs. Rebecca Linnemeier welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

In the Superintendent's Report, Dr. Edington reported close to 20,000 people attended the Red For Ed Day in Indianapolis. The WCEA President Angela Lortie was present and thanked the board for supporting the WCEA and the students. They are very appreciative of the relationship we have with each other and putting

the students first and working with the association. The Legislature approved the Teacher Appreciation Grant, which was paid on a separate pay on December 4, 2019 to the teachers. This grant did not go to Administrators or Classified Staff. Dr. Edington and Mr. Don Bokhart will be attending a breakfast at Fairfield Schools on December 20, 2019 with area legislators to learn about their education priorities in the Indiana State Legislature and offer perspectives back to them. Spring and Summer Construction Project Bids will include Wawasee High School renovation of restrooms, locker rooms, circle area classrooms and some safety doors. Wawasee Middle School will include renovations in restrooms, floor drains and brick work on the outside and top of the building. There will be alternate bids for paint, carpet and the parking lot. The state has not released scores associated with the spring testing. The solar panels are up and running in 3 of our areas, and we have received the first invoices that reflect the 50% savings. The bus garage, Syracuse Elementary and Wawasee High School use REMC and are showing a savings. REMC has a cap on the savings of 50% and we are right there. The NIPSCO buildings are progressing. Milford is waiting on a transformer, Wawasee Middle School will be ready to hook up in the next few months and North Webster Elementary should be hooked up this week.

There were no other items. Holiday cookies were served after the meeting.

Mr. Mike Wilson moved to adjourn. Mr. Don Bokhart seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:33 p.m.
