

ONLINE OPTION FOR STUDENT LEARNING

During the COVID19 pandemic, families will have the choice of selecting an online-only option for students to engage in remote learning full time. This opportunity will be provided and facilitated by Wawasee teaching staff and will take advantage of several types of instruction for students depending on the grade level and course.

Please keep in mind that the online option cannot replicate the full academic, social, and emotional student experience that comes from being in school. It is possible that students will not have every academic option available to them in a remote-learning environment, particularly at the secondary level. Specifically, elective / encore options may be limited due to availability and compatibility of material in the online environment. To that end, students enrolling in the online-only option will not participate in any school extracurricular activities and events, including school athletic programs.

In order to prepare the online-only option, allocate resources and assign staff, it is important to know how many students will participate in this model of instruction. We are asking families to make a commitment for at least 1 trimester when signing up for the remote-learning option. After July 31st, enrollment requests will be considered on a case by case basis and will be subject to availability.

What is offered at each level?

Preschool: Remote learning services will only be provided for students who receive services for an Individualized Learning Plan (IEP) and will be consistent with the IEP.

Elementary (K-5th Grade): Students will receive direct daily instruction from a licensed, grade-level WCSC teacher in the areas of Reading, Writing, and Math. Classroom activities will consist of recorded lessons, live interactive sessions with teachers, routine assessments, and corresponding learning activities and assignments designed to support student learning. Social Studies, Science, and Encore activities will be developed and facilitated for students to participate in each week. Parents will be able to communicate directly with the classroom teacher for questions and support. A school-provided device and learning platform (Google Classroom, Seesaw, etc.) will be provided for each student participating in this learning model.

Secondary (6-12th Grade): Middle school and high school students will receive instruction from several instructional options to fill out a rounded and robust schedule. These options may include remote "live" coursework, recorded lessons posted to an online learning platform (Google Classroom) or coursework through APEX Learning. Students opting for a remote learning option will be assigned to a remote learning support team consisting of teachers, counselors, and learning coaches to support students as they progress through learning in a digital environment. A school-provided device and learning platform (Google Classroom) will be available for each student participating in this learning model.
