Mrs. Joy Goshert presented the Student Learning Report with the assistance of Mr. Dave VanLue, Director of Technology. Mr. VanLue presented the board with an update on the 1:1 initiative. He reported that the teacher devices are in the hands of the teachers right now and bids have been accepted for the infrastructure updates that are needed to support the devices. Mr. Jace Stewart and Mr. Todd Lucas have been approved to attend the Apple Academy this summer. Smart Starts for teachers are being used to train staff on the devices and a model of teaching with the devices. Internet Bandwidth upgrades are scheduled for May and June. 5 Star has been employed to help lead professional development for staff. Mrs. Goshert presented on the first couple of days of ISTEP+ testing. Wawasee continues to have some issues with connectivity but nothing like it has been in the past. Kindergarten round up was held at all 3 elementary schools with the turn out as expected for those schools. Wawasee is also planning on holding Kindergarten Countdown and, depending on the enrollment, would like to have a class at each of the elementary schools. She reported to the board that Wawasee has been awarded the Indiana Literacy Early Intervention Grant from the Indiana Department of Education. We have also submitted a grant application to the DEKKO Foundation for Instructional Coaching in each elementary school along with professional development through the Buck Institute for Education.
